Think before you Leap

To continue with the counting theme, this month I've come up with yet another hand I "blew." This was from the recent Tunica Regional. My blunder turned this match around and we lost in the second round to the Cappelletti team.

It was a very interesting hand and serves as a good learning point. With me sitting South, both sides vulnerable:

North:	♠ x x x x	Bidding:	N	E	S	W

Opening Trick: ♠ J, ♠ x, ♠ K!, ♠ A

OK! It's time to count and visualize. What do we think we know? Well, it looks like West has something close to:

- ♠ J 10 9 x x
- ♥ A J x x
- ♦ A Q ?
- ♣ ? ?

(Warning! West, Mike Cappelletti, Jr., is known to be extremely wild and makes frequent gambling bids!) I wondered if Mike was trying to throw me off and in fact had a void in hearts (after all, we are limited: 1♥—2♥ and then game try accepted means probably no more than 28 high card points). However, after some thought I decided that even he with only:

- ♠ J 10 x x x
- ♥ —
- ♦ A Q x x
- ♣ J x x x

(8 HCPs) would not dare double. I correctly played the ♥ K and sure enough found West (Mike) with ♥ A J x x. He ducked. Now what? To assess my losers it looks like I have 1 spade, 1 heart, and 2 diamonds—down 1 unless I can somehow endplay Mike at the end to lead

diamonds into me, right? Right!

After playing the third heart toward the ♥ Q, Mike took the ♥ A and played back his last heart. East threw 3 clubs and 1 diamond. Now time to do more counting. East clearly has 12 minor cards with probably no more than ♠ K and a minor J in his hand. (What in the world was that hesitation about? Being red and barely any points, probably has big distribution, huh?)

Anyway, I now realized I had Mike! All I had to do was to cash all my clubs (he can't have more than 3) and come down to:

	♠ x x x
	♥ —
	♦ x x
	♣ —
	♠ 10 9 x
	♥ —
	♦ A Q
	♣ —
	♠ A x
	♥ x
	♦ K J
	♣ —

I can now cash the heart and he has to discard. If he discards a spade I play ♠ A and ♠ x and he has to play into my ♦ K J. If instead he throws a diamond I play ♦ J from hand and my ♦ K is good. Victory! Right? Wrong!! The cad in fact had only 4 spades and no ♦ Q!!! That hesitation by Righty now came to light. He and Mike had:

Mike	Righty
♠ J 10 x x	♠ K x
♥ A J x x	♥ —
♦ A x x x	♦ Q x x x x
♣ x	♣ J x x x x x

I was classically careless. I could have had the same ending and landed on the board. Duh!! I only needed to cash my heart first and then go to the board and play out clubs and play a diamond from the board when he didn't throw a spade. Just in case he made another one of his ridiculous bids?!? Think before you leap!! Will I ever learn this game? The answer is clear—NO!

P.S. I wonder whether that hesitation prompted the horrendous double.

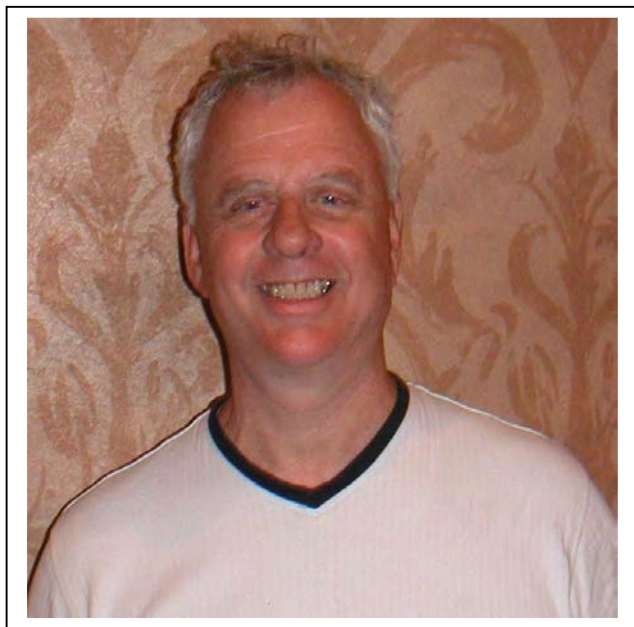
