Allan Siebert won the Leventritt Silver Ribbon Pairs at the Spring North American Bridge Championships in St. Louis. Allan and his partner Alan Stout were in 10th place after the qualifying rounds but won by more than a full board with a 62.65% first final session and a 57.36% second final. The four-session contest is restricted to members 55 and older who had previously qualified to enter. On the all-time list of ACBL masterpoint holders, Allan is #23 with almost 27,000.

How do you think auction should go?

Suggested Auction:

N	E	S	W

Bid Analysis: South doesn't have enough points to change suits at the two level, so bids 1NT which shows 6 to a bad 10 HCP, less than 4 spades, and less than 3 hearts. North jumps to 3♥ showing more than 5 hearts and 16-18 points. South has 9 HCP and 2 hearts. That's at top of 1NT bid, so bids 4♥, not 3NT.

Your lead?

Suggested opening lead: spade ace.

Lead analysis: I don't like any lead. Can't lead a heart. A good rule to follow: NEVER LEAD AWAY FROM A JACK IN AN UNBID SUIT AGAINST A SUIT CONTRACT UNLESS IT IS TOP OF SEQUENCE. So don't lead a club. A diamond lead is a passive lead and the spade ace is an aggressive lead. I like aggressive leads, hence the space ace. Another rule to follow: NEVER LEAD LOW FROM AN ACE AGAINST A SUIT CONTRACT. That means if you lead that suit, lead the ace, don't lead low. Aces were built to catch kings, but you only have the choice of a spade or a diamond, neither one of which is appealing.

Plan your play.

Play analysis: This hand is cut and dried. Declarer takes the heart finesse which loses, then calls trumps and catches the rest of the tricks. If East's opening lead is not a spade, then he should cash the spade when in with the heart king. The clubs appear to be setting up for discards if North has the ace.

Summary: 4♥ by North should catch 11 tricks. ♥

Ethel was honored at the Seniors Game on February 26th as the oldest player present at the game. She has been playing since the 1920's. She still plays a mean game.

Ethel grew up in Brighton, Illinois, a small town near St. Louis. The town had a yearly picnic which, like many small towns of the era, was very well attended and drew people from all over the area. Ethel was allowed to attend and in 1927, the same year Charles Lindbergh made his transatlantic flight, he was at the Brighton picnic giving rides for \$1.00. Before Ethel left home, her mother asked her to please not ride on the back of a motorcycle, and Ethel honored her mother's wishes. Instead, she went up with Lindbergh in his plane.

Being claustrophobic, this was the only time Ethel ever flew. She traveled the country, but never again by plane.

She graduated from William Woods in 1933 and Northwestern in 1935 with a B.S. in speech. At William Woods girls were not allowed to ride in cars with boys without a chaperone, but somehow she managed to meet her future husband Craig.

The 1934 World's Fair was held in Chicago and Ethel was hired to do the lighting for the Children's Theatre. Before the fair took place Ethel was contacted and told it wouldn't be possible for her to do this since all workers had to be in the union and women weren't allowed to join a union then.

Ethel and Craig were married 50 years before he passed away 19 years ago. He played bridge, too. They had two children; Craig Jr. who lives both in Dallas and Savannah, Georgia, and their daughter Joyce Glenn who also lives in Savannah. She is also blessed with four grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. ♣

From Little Rock/North Little Rock: Cantrell/Highway 10 - and travel west. Follow Highway 10- 8.5 miles from I-430 cross-over, turn left onto Ferndale Cutoff (West Pulaski Fire Department will be on the right). Follow Ferndale Cutoff 5 miles to stop sign in Ferndale. Travel another 1.1 miles on Ferndale Cutoff. The 4-H Center will be on the right.

From I-430: After crossing the Arkansas River from the north, take the first exit - Cantrell/Highway 10 - and travel west (right).
